



## SPARKLING WINE

**Prosecco DOC Corte delle Calli Extra Dry, Italy**  
A classic Prosecco with aromas of white peach, pear and flowers. The palate is fresh, not too dry, and clean as a whistle all the way through to the sparkling finish.

**Viticoltori Acquesi Rosé Brut, Italy**  
A beautiful pale pink colour, with a delicate aroma of spring flowers and orchard fruit, refined bubbles, and a crisp fruity finish.

Impressively full-flavoured fizz, with green apple and elderflower aromas backed up by good yeasty depth on the palate.

## CHAMPAGNE

**Champagne Laurent-Perrier, France**  
Well defined, subtly rounded with expressive flavours. The fruit progressively emerges to reveal a finely balanced champagne displaying great length on the finish.

**Champagne Laurent-Perrier Rosé, France**  
Intensely fruity flavours begin clean and well-defined upon entry, the wine then opens up to provide a melange of flavours consisting of fresh strawberries, raspberries and wild cherries. **£82.50**

**Champagne Krug Grande Cuvée, France**  
An extravagantly expansive bouquet and creamy texture. Then, an explosion of sensations - luscious fruitiness, hints of hazelnut and toast, then a final flourish of freshness. Outstanding. **£199.95**

## WHITE WINE

**Kleinkloof Chenin Blanc, South Africa**  
Very attractive nose with lots of tropical fruits such as pineapple, guava and citrus fruit, carrying on to the crisp, refreshing palate.

**Joie de Vigne Marsanne/Vermentino, France**  
A zesty aromatic white combining aromas and flavours of citrus fruit, pineapple and white flowers with a ripe, subtly textured palate and dry finish. **£21.50**

**The Swooper Fiano, Australia**  
Fiano is a grape originally native to southern Italy but which thrives in the Australian sunshine. Here it produces a wine that is fresh and vibrant, with ripe pear and citrus flavours, and an appealing floral note on the finish.

**Vinho Verde Anjos de Portugal, Quinta da Lixa, Portugal**  
A fine, modern wine, with aromas of apple and grapefruit alongside herbal notes. The palate is medium-bodied and refreshing, with the classic touch of spritz. **£23.95**

**Finca La Colonia Torrontés, Argentina**  
A sophisticated, dry, elegant rendition of this aromatic grape variety, combining minerality with white peach and floral notes such as rose and jasmine.

**Quercus Pinot Bianco, Slovenia**  
On the nose there are notes of apple, grapefruit and lemon, as well as a pleasant floral aroma. Smooth and full-bodied on the palate, with a long finish. **£24.95**

**Promesa Rioja Blanco, Spain**  
Silky and smooth on the palate with well-balanced flavours and a long finish. **£23.50**

**Révélation Viognier, Badet Clément, France**  
Bursting with typical flavours of apricot and peach alongside elegant floral notes. The palate is round, with a refreshing acidity and a perfectly balanced finish.

**Villa Bianchi Verdicchio Castelli di Jesi Classico, Umani Ronchi, Italy**  
Fresh and fruity, with a typical combination of green apple fruit and a hint of bitter almonds. Bright and aromatic, lifted by a clean streak of acidity on the finish.

**Zero-G Grüner Veltliner, Austria**  
Light in body yet intensely flavoured, this Grüner Veltliner offers the typical white pepper and crisp green fruit aromas of the variety, allied to a creamy texture particular to the Wagram region. The balance is really satisfying, the wine refreshing from start to finish. **£26.95**

**Castel Firmian Pinot Grigio, Mezzacorona, Italy**  
Very clean, nicely balanced Pinot Grigio, with a gentle floral aroma, good medium weight in the mouth, and a refreshing finish.

**Mount Holdsworth Sauvignon Blanc, Wairarapa, New Zealand**  
This North Island Sauvignon marries the variety's typical zesty, grassy aroma to real texture and succulence. Green apple and passion fruit flavours turn crisp and mineral on the finish.

**Founders Block Chardonnay, Katnook Estate, Australia**  
This stylish Chardonnay offers subtle peach and nectarine aromas offset by some grapefruit zing and a touch of toast. The palate blends vibrant fruit flavours with an appealing creaminess, finishing on citrus.

**Albariño Casal Caeiro, Spain**  
From the coolest part of Rias Baixas, this wine bursts with juicy Albariño character: pear, citrus fruit, musky perfume and hints of mineral and spice. Clean, intense and very long on the palate. **£31.50**

**Gavi di Gavi La Meirana, Italy**  
Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, this is particularly characterful Gavi. **£32.95**

**Riesling, Muré, France**  
A fresh nose with aromas of fruit, particularly citrus. Rich and elegant on the palate, with a streak of lime freshness. Exotic fruit and minerality on the finish. **£34.95**

**Mahi Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand**  
Inviting aromas and flavours of lemon-lime, pepper and herbs, plus a subtle suggestion of ripe peach. Plush and broad but with harmonious, spicy grapefruit notes giving the wine lift. Fresh but fully ripe, with a long aftertaste. **£35.95**

**Chablis, Jean-Marc Brocard, France**  
The nose is precise, pure and mineral, with additional notes of citrus. The palate is classic Chablis: structured, crisp and delicious, with flavours echoing the nose. **£40.95**

**Pouilly-Fumé Les Chailloux, France**  
A lively, intense nose of green fruit, then focused mineral notes on the palate backed up by zippy citrus and some spice and mint flavours. **£42.50**

### FINE WINE

**Chablis 1er Cru Vau Ligneau, Domaine Hamelin 2016/17, France**  
Delicate, expressive nose with green apple, citrus and lily aromas. Round yet elegant on the palate, with classic minerality and a dry finish. **£47.95**

**Rully Blanc 1er Cru Les Cloux, Vincent Girardin 2015, France**  
Rich and complex with mineral notes. Rully produces the most elegant whites of the Côte Chalonnaise, and this wine stands fair comparison to its more famous northerly neighbours in the Côte d'Or. **£54.95**

**Puligny-Montrachet, Henri de Villamont 2016, France**  
Rich and complex, with enduring mineral notes. Flavours of almonds, fresh stone fruits and white flowers sit well against the toasty, spicy notes from the oak-ageing. **£95.50**

## ROSÉ WINE

**Poggio Alto Pinot Grigio Rosé, Italy**  
With a delicate pale pink colour and an elegant nose of acacia flowers, this light-bodied dry rosé is delightfully refreshing.

**Valdemar Rioja Rosado, Spain**  
Clear, pale salmon colour, with delicate raspberry fruit and the elegant herbal finish of Garnacha, overlaid with floral notes from the Viura.

**M de Minuty Côtes de Provence Rosé, France**

## DESSERT WINE

### **Château des Arroucats, Ste Croix du Mont, France**

Classic aromas of candied citrus and tropical fruits, honey and blossom introduce this delicious wine. The palate is the perfect balance of sweetness and freshness.

### **Buitenverwachting 1769 Muscat, South Africa**

This classical Constantia dessert wine offers ripe apricot, melon, and apple like characters. The initial sensation is sweet, but due to crisp natural acids the wine has a firm and full finish.

### **Tokaji Late Harvest Cuvee, Sauska, Hungary**

Gorgeously rich yet precisely balanced, this classic Tokaji presents flavours of dried peach, apricot and toffee, all cut with a zesty citrus note. There is intensity and power here, but a lightness of touch that makes it decidedly moreish.

## PORT AND COGNAC

### **Ferreira LBV Port, Portugal**

The intense aroma is dominated by very ripe black fruit along with chocolate, cocoa and a slight hint of pepper. In the mouth it is a full-bodied wine with great balance between sweetness and richness of structure.

### **Ferreira 10 Years Old Dona Antonia Tawny Port**

An excellent balance between floral, ripe fruit and the spicy dry fruit associated with long ageing in barrel. The palate shows the classic, fresh Ferreira style, achieving fine balance and a long finish.

### **Tesseron Composition Cognac, France**

A light, bright amber colour with fresh plum, spiced fruit and freshly cut flowers on the nose and a complex, fruity palate.

One the nose, fresh pear and quince notes followed by dried fruits and nuts. Fresh and intriguing with hints of almond. A firm, focused and powerful palate which mirrors the nose.

## RED WINE

### **Cuvée Louis Vincent Rouge, Duboeuf, France**

A soft, smooth red with juicy cherry and blackberry fruit lifted by a touch of spice.

### **Morandé Pionero Merlot Reserva, Chile**

This beautifully balanced Merlot combines smooth ripe plum and raspberry fruit with some savoury cinnamon spice and a neat medium-bodied texture, finishing on notes of dark chocolate.

### **The Swooper Pinot Noir, Australia**

This Pinot Noir is full of ripe and juicy red berry fruit with soft, smooth tannins, giving a wine that is both delicious and easy drinking.

Ripe plums and red fruit combine with sweet cinnamon and a hint of black pepper on the finish. Juicy with soft, supple tannins.

### **Promesa Rioja Crianza, Spain**

A classic style of Rioja, with strawberry, blackberry and rhubarb fruit flavours taking on a vanilla and cocoa smoothness during twelve months in oak barrels.

### **Tormaresca Nèprica Negroamaro, Puglia, Italy**

Red fruits, black cherry and notes of liquorice. The palate is well-rounded, with soft, supple tannins and a pleasingly fresh finish.

Deep red colour with violet hues. Aromas of ripe red fruit, cassis and black pepper, with more fruit and a touch of spice on the palate. Elegant and smooth with a long finish.

### **Côtes-du-Rhône Samorëns Rouge, Ferraton, France**

Medium to full-bodied, the bright, fresh cherry and berry fruit is followed by a savoury earthy note. The tannins are silky and well rounded and the finish is fresh.

### **Lost Angel California Pinot Noir, USA**

Silky and smooth, this Pinot Noir has strawberry and plum aromas, complimented by spicy pepper and brown sugar with cherry fruit and sweet oak. There's a blend of riper, fruitier flavours with an interesting Pinot earthiness.

### **Parsons Nose Shiraz Chapel Hill, Australia**

Classic Shiraz aromas of blueberries, blackberries and cinnamon lead to a luscious yet lively palate that balances typical McLaren Vale fruit density with a floral-spicy lift.

### **Quinta da Cassa Douro Reserva, Portugal**

Dense with ripe blackberries and elegant floral hints alongside subtle spice and vanilla notes from the oak. An opulent and lengthy finish, with a refreshing acidity.

### **Conde Valdemar Rioja Reserva, Spain**

Complex aromas with subtle spicy notes and ripe black fruit touches, leading to a generous, intense palate full of plums, raisins and chocolate. Beautiful balance of fruit and oak, with a long, persistent finish.

### **Privada Family Blend (Malbec/Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot), Norton, Argentina**

Excellent aromatic complexity with notes of ripe fruit, spices, and hints of smoke and coffee. Rich and generous on the palate with superb concentration.

### **Château Bernadotte, Haut-Medoc, France**

Bright black cherry and raspberry fruit on the nose with dried leaf and graphite notes lending complexity. This is well defined and displays good vigor. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannins, supple in the mouth with clean, fresh and mineral red fruit.

### **Villa Antinori Chianti Classico Riserva, Italy**

A rich, modern Chianti that marries beautifully ripe cherry fruit with well-judged smoky oak notes. The opulence on the palate is tempered by savoury notes of clove and a firm structure supporting the plump fruit.

## FINE WINE

### **Chassagne-Montrachet Rouge Vieilles Vignes 2017, France**

Pure red fruit jumps out of the glass – these old vines always provide a lovely clear expression of Pinot Noir. In the mouth, it is fairly full, with a firm structure and some spicy blackberry flavours.

### **Châteauneuf-du-Pape Le Parvis, Ferraton 2016, France**

A dense wine, with notes of sour cherries, plum, roasted coffee and leather. Fleshy, with fine and rounded tannins that coat the palate and carry on through the long, savoury finish.

### **Barolo, Prunotto 2015, Italy**

Complex nose with notes of rose, strawberry and forest fruits. Delicately floral, perfumed yet persistent on the palate, Barolo at its best.

### **Costasera Amarone della Valpolicella Classico 2013, Masi, Italy**

Bright and intense on the nose with aromas of preserved cherries and dried plums together with hints of fruits of the forest and cinnamon. Good weight from the alcohol and structured on the palate, opening out to attractive aromas of cherries and vanilla. Long, velvety finish.

### **Château Patache, Badine de la Patache Pomerol 2014, France**

Full and rich, with juicy black fruit flavours leading to a bold, spicy finish. The firm tannins are perfectly offset by a seam of acidity running through to the harmonious finish.

### **Estate Cabernet Sauvignon, Silverado Vineyards 2014/2015, USA**

A textbook example of Stags Leap Cabernet. Primary flavours of black cherry and ripe plums which evolve into subtle hints of licorice and tobacco, framed by bold but velvety tannins. The perfect combination of ripe fruit and savoury complexity.

### **Pommard Vieilles Vignes, Vincent Girardin 2016, France**

Expressive and structured with notes of forest fruits, game and a bold seam of acidity. The tannins are firm at first, but soften out on the lengthy finish.

A seamless marriage of freshness and depth, this offers rich black cherry and blackberry fruit, subtle mocha oak and a round, generous finish.
